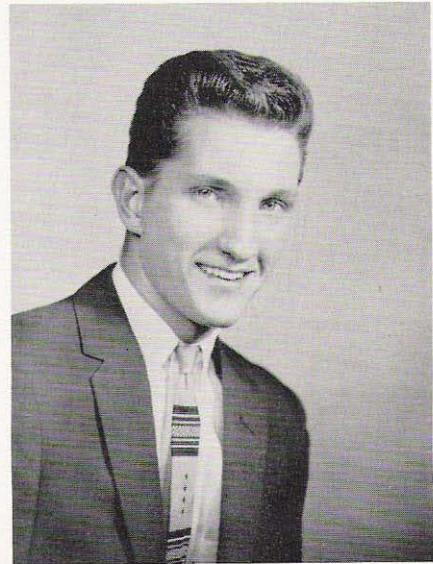

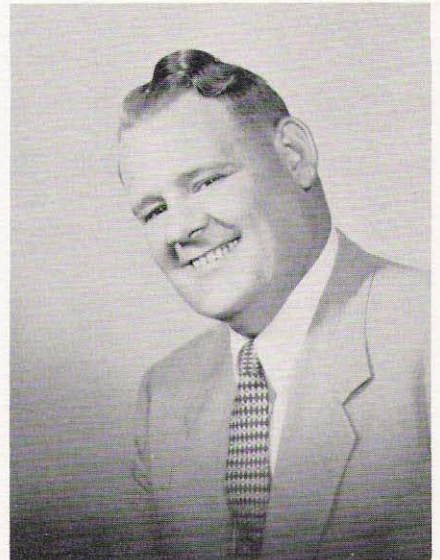

Baccalaureate Services were held on May 11, 1958, and Commencement was held on May 14, 1958.

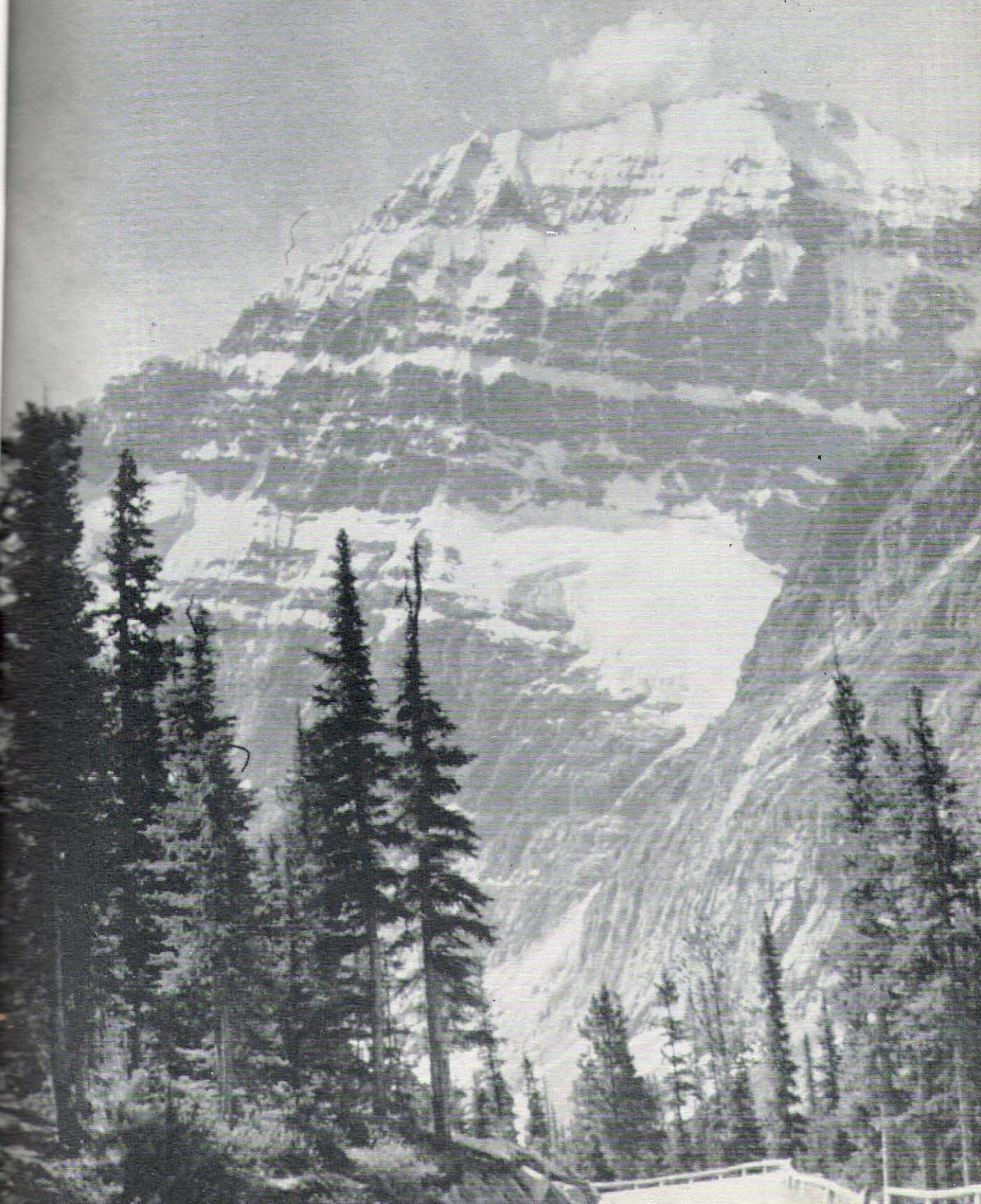

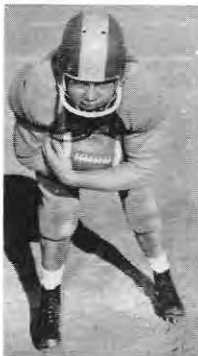

Highlighted by a second place finish in the Eckley Basketball Jamboree, early in the season, the Eagles went on to finish a mediocre basketball season.

Scoring 747 points in 16 games for a 46.6 points per game average as compared to the oppositions 851 points for a 53.1 game average, they finished with a 6 won-10 lost record.

John Corder and Eugene Schwartz led the scoring for the Eagles with 246 points and 218 points, respectively for a game average of 15.3 points and 13.6 points each.

The remaining three starters scored as follows: Dale Cline 100 points, average 6.2 per game; Norman Beeson 86 points, average 5.3 per game; Kenneth Stute 65 points, average 4.3 per game.

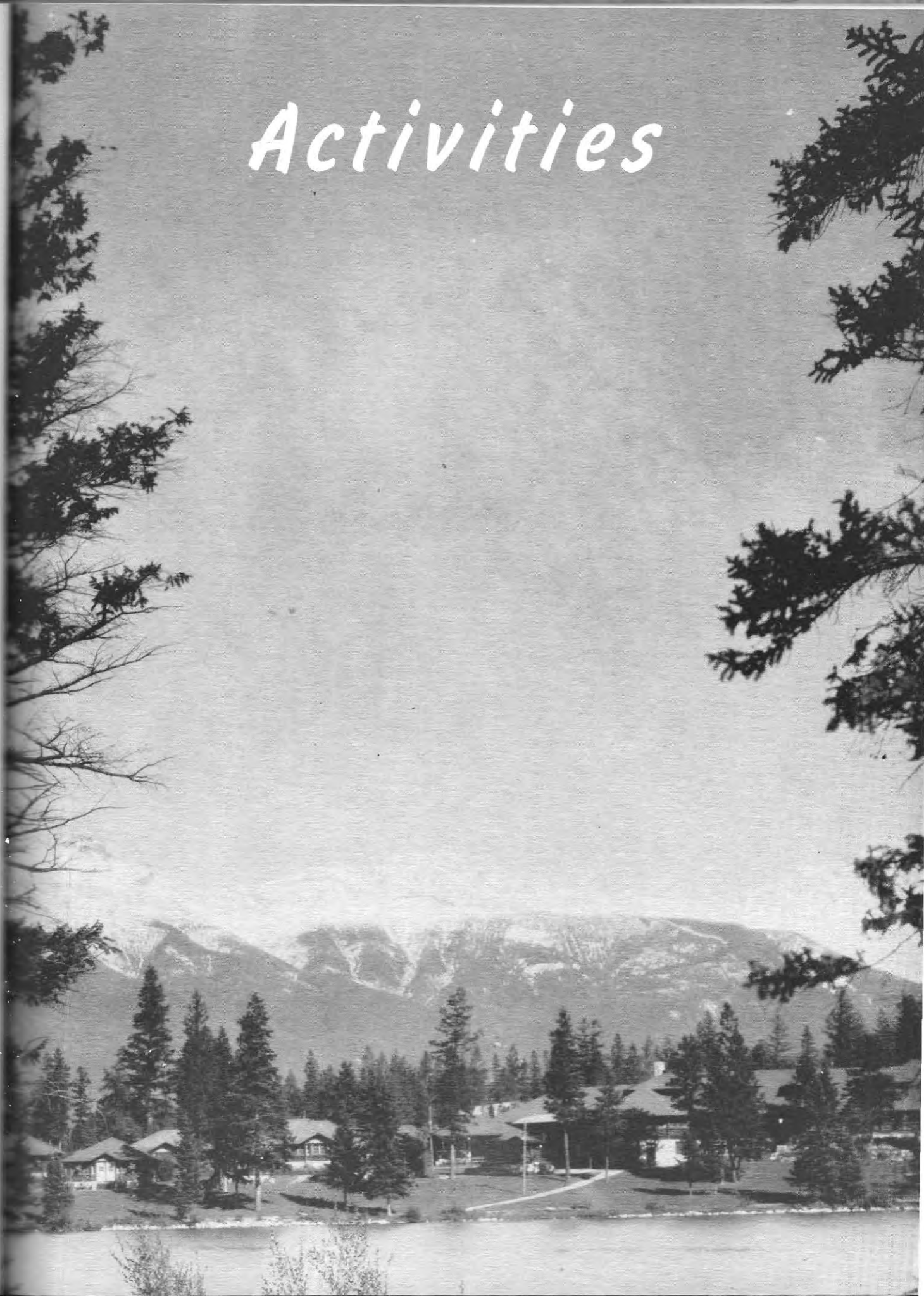
