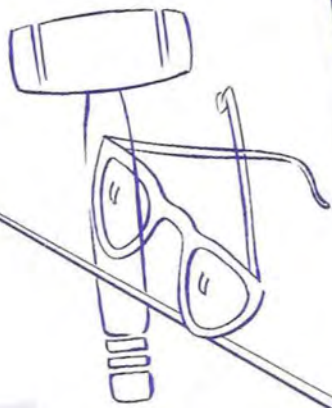
As we recall the past, happy memories come to us; but none happier than our thoughts of you, Mom and Dad. You gave us the strength and courage to face the first flight of stairs.

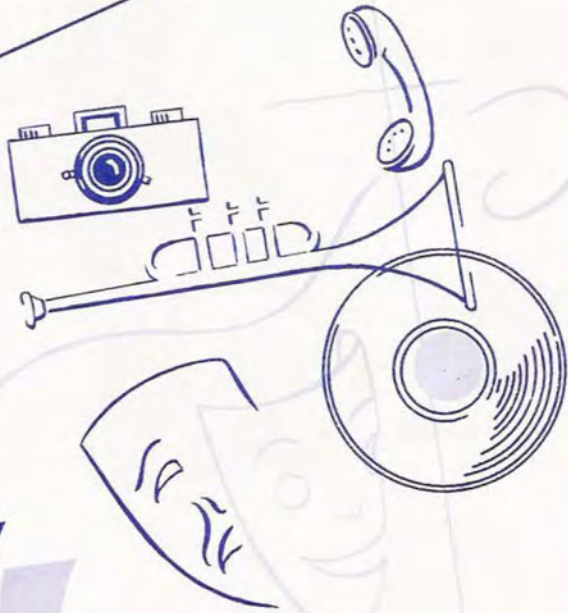
