This is the city, Haigler, Nebraska. The Year? 1974. The date? May 15th. The place? The high school gymnasium. The night had an air of mystery.

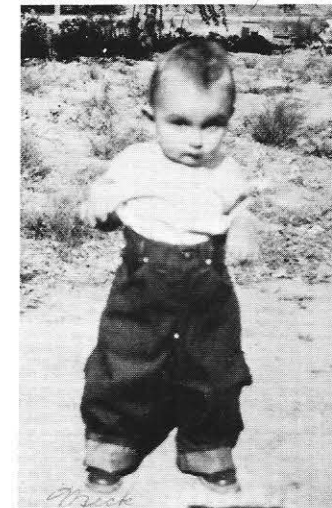
As I walked into the gym, I could count only eight people; one was missing.

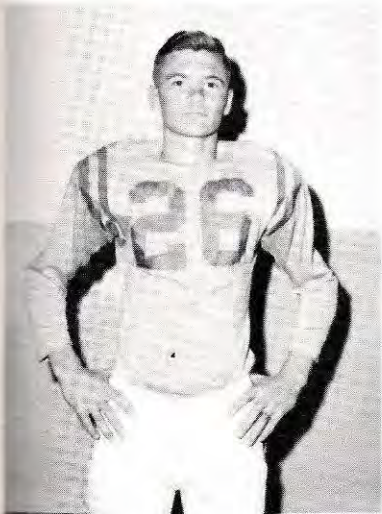
Mick Schorzman

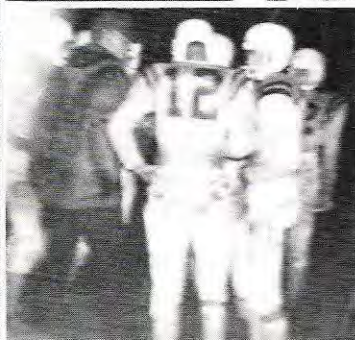
Ed Neville

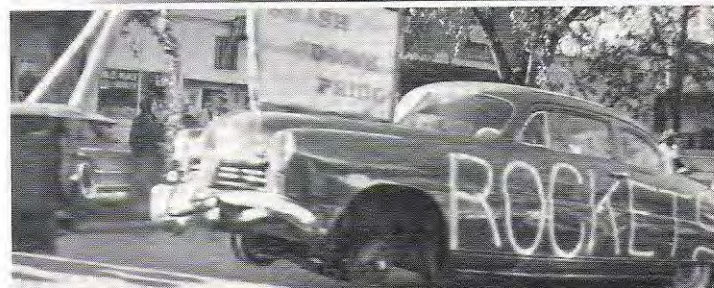
# Homecoming 1963

On Friday, November 1st, at 2:30 o'clock, the Haigler Homecoming activities for 1963 began with a parade which assembled at the high school and proceeded down main street. The float judges were Jim Norsworthy and Leo Williams of Benkelman.

At half-time of the game with Edson, Kansas, Alfred Zuege, Homecoming King of 1962, crowned Mary Ann Mahon as the Homecoming Queen. She then crowned the King, Merle Wheaton. The Queen's attendants were DeVonna Smith and Janice Blank; the King's attendants were Mick Schorzman and Ed Neville. Also at half-time, Alfred presented the prizes to the winners of the parade floats. The Senior float received fourth place, the first and second grades won third prize, the Freshman class won second place, and the seventh and eighth grades received top honors with their slogan, "The Eagles are Putting all Their Beggs in One Asket".

On Saturday at 8 o'clock, Rodney Gaston and Debra Akey cut the ribbon that led to the throne which was a huge football helmet. The King and Queen and their attendants then walked through the gym which was decorated in the school colors, purple and gold, to bring out the theme, "Football".
