Stan, captain of the football team, led the team in unassisted tackles from defensive back position.

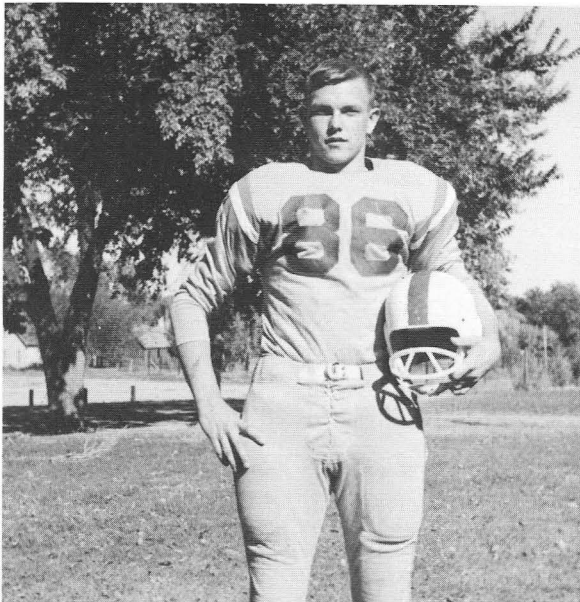
MARV SIMS
