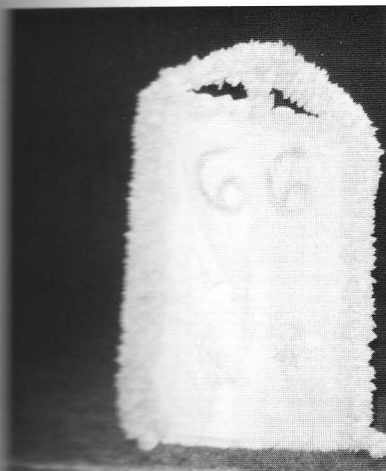
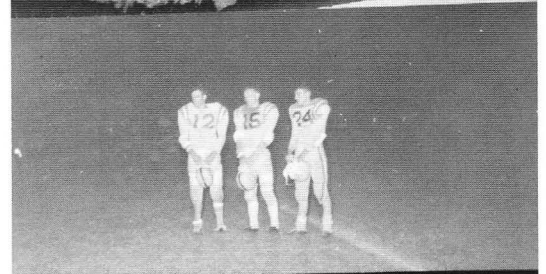


Homecoming 1966

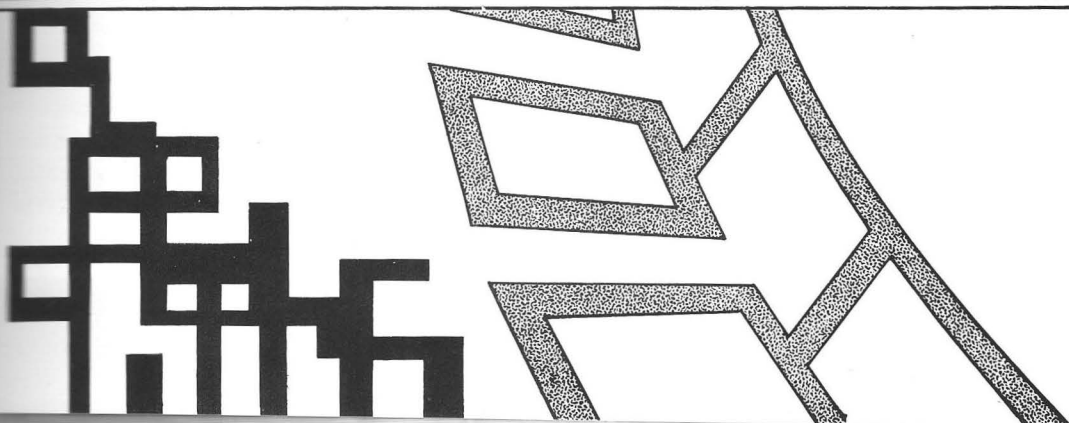
Jr.-Sr. Banquet & Prom
