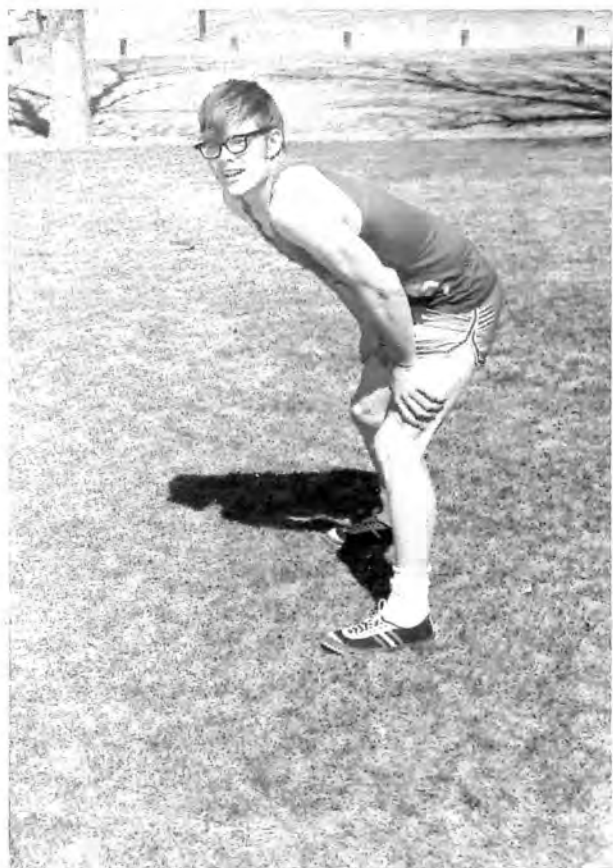

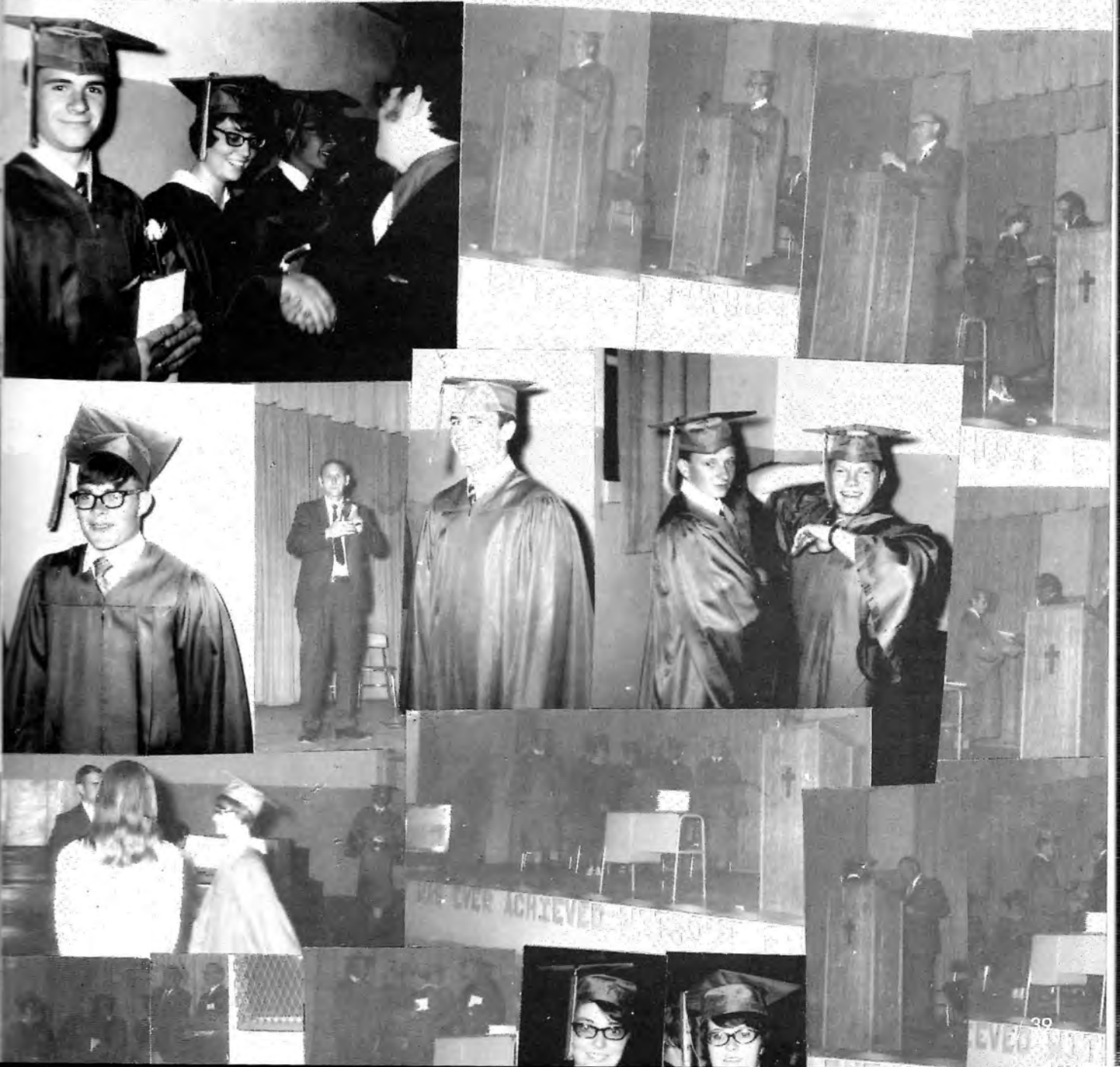

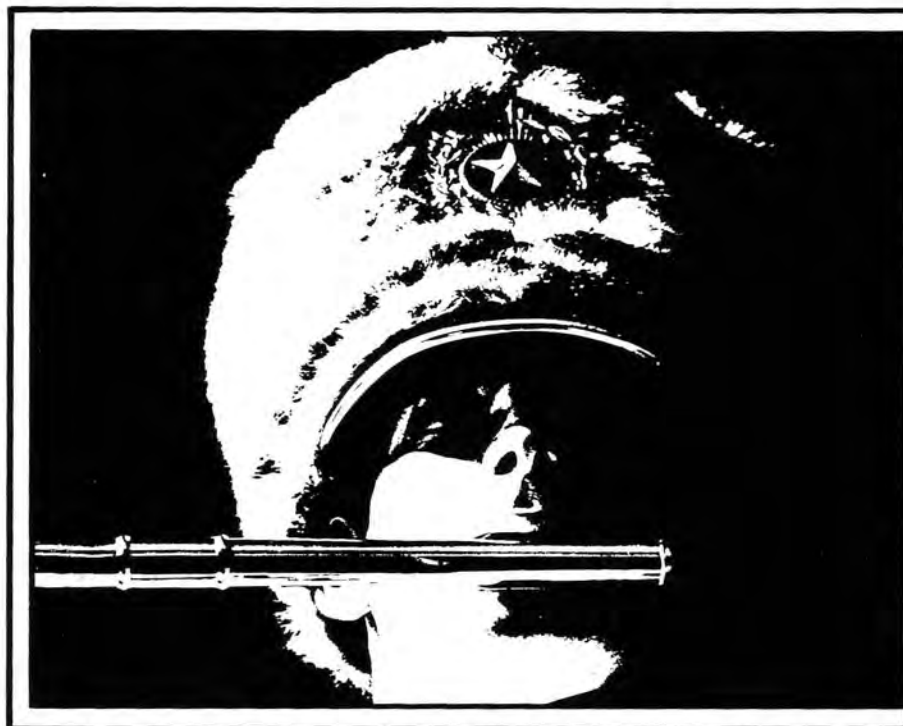
GRADUATION

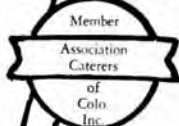
